CALL FOR PROPOSALS 2015-2016
Joint Projects**

Seoul National University (SNU) and Université Paris Diderot (UPD) have decided to engage in a privileged partnership with the objective of fostering new collaborations in higher education and research between France and South Korea. Its principal objective is to promote a long-standing cooperation between the two partners across diverse disciplines, from life, physical and engineering sciences to social sciences and the humanities.

To launch the partnership, SNU and UPD will first host two workshops, one in Paris and one in Seoul, in October 2015 and in June 2016. These meetings will allow the departments, laboratories and faculty involved to examine the specificities of their planned collaborations and decide on their roadmaps. In research it is hoped that this will allow the setting up of Joint International Laboratories. In teaching, the aim would be to offer joint or double programmes and degrees.

The present Call for Proposals will allow the two institutions to select jointly the first projects eligible for the workshops. Priority will be given to innovative and/or interdisciplinary projects.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The present Call for joint projects is open to lecturers and researchers in all disciplines from the two institutions. Projects must be submitted jointly by full-time faculty members from both SNU and UPD wishing to start a new collaboration or strengthen an existing one. Third parties from other institutions or research agencies are welcome to take part, but will not receive direct funding.

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

- Cover page: including the project title, e-mail, telephone number and institutional affiliation of each principal investigator
- Abstract: one paragraph outlining the project, suitable for public reports and communication materials
- Narrative: (2000 words maximum, excluding references) describing the project, theoretical approach, methodology, existing literature, value of the French-Korean collaboration in the field, and the potential of the project for future endeavours between the two institutions, including the possibility of obtaining external funding
- Curriculum vitae: for the project investigators, with a list of their five most recent publications
- Anticipated budget and format for the workshops: (one page) outlining the expected costs by categories (travel and living expenses, hosting a workshop, consumables, human resources, etc.)
