

Samir Tawk:        about unions

The major problem in the Arab World is the absence of freedom, especially the freedom of forming independent unions that contribute in building a good political regime.

The best solution is to generalize a common culture about rights and duties, which starts in families, schools, and communities and in private and official institutions, because it is everyone's duty to teach people about their rights and how to defend them.

By our struggle we give a model to the workers on how to defend their dignity and humanity by forming and affiliating to unions in order to improve their working conditions and reach a free living.

All this labor's struggle will lead to a balance between production partners, workers and patrons, and will guide us to a more just and fair society. In fact, the union elections that will take place in the 18 of November 2012 will be the real model of freedom and equity.

Finally we are determined to go on with this struggle until we realize all our rights and the trade union demands, despite all the pressure exercised over us by the Spinneys' direction : the withdrawal of unionists memberships using terrorism and threatens. However, nothing will prevent us from continuing the mission that will open the path to freedom for other oppressed workers.
